

ATTENDANCE

ADMISSION GUIDELINES

Students who have passed HSLC Examination or equivalent examination from any recognised Board.

A student desiring to take up Commerce stream must get the qualifying grades in Mathematics at Class 10 Examination.

Science:

A student desiring to take up Science stream must get qualifying grades in Mathematics-A and Science at Class 10 Examination.
